

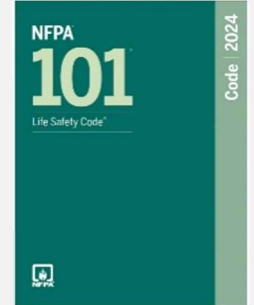
NFPA 101® - Life Safety Code®



The NFPA 101 Life Safety Code® focuses on occupant safety throughout the life cycle of a building, covering both new and existing structures. Updated every three years to reflect evolving safety standards, the current code includes several key updates:

- **New requirements for carbon monoxide detectors**
- **Changes to interior exit discharge requirements**
- **Increased number of fire extinguishers:** How many do you need?
- **Health care compliance with NFPA 241:** Standard for Safeguarding Construction, Alteration, and Demolition Operations

Participants will learn about the requirements that enhance the safety of people and the protection of property and equipment. The course will review construction, protection, and occupancy features necessary to minimize life-threatening dangers from the effects of fire - including smoke, heat, and toxic gases produced during a fire.
